- NCEA entry fee – approx. \$383.30 per candidate. This fee is for year 11, 12 & 13 students only.
- Competitions: Students will have the opportunity to enter national competitions. Typically, these are in Mathematics, Science, English & Chemistry or cultural competitions.
- Involvement in extra-curricular activities; sports, culture, and clubs.
